## Call for Artists Open to Public

### *An Olympic Peninsula Art Association Fundraiser*

The Olympic Peninsula Art Association (OPAA) is seeking original art entries, in any medium, for the next exhibit, “Small Wonders Art Show & Sale,” to be held November 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Sequim Civic Center Council Chambers, located 152 W. Cedar Street.

**Deadline for submissions is Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m.** There is no fee to enter. OPAA is implementing a new application process for this exhibit. To enter online: click to follow or copy & paste the link: <https://www.jotform.com/92177292539164>, complete the online form, and attach one digital image (preferably 300 ppi) for each entry (no more than 2).

**\*\*If online entry is not possible,** you may bring your entry(s) to one of two help sessions on Thursday, October 17<sup>th</sup> from 4—6 p.m., or Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. in the KSQM Radio station conference room located at 609 W. Washington St, Sequim, WA. OPAA members will be there to guide and help you complete the online process and take digital photos of your work.

**Entry Guidelines:**

- All media (2D & 3D) will be accepted from both OPAA members & non-members.
- Entries must be original artworks and are limited to two (2) per artist.
- All entries must be no larger than 12 inches on any one side, including frames. This also applies to 3D work.
- 2D artwork must be matted and backed to protect the work, framing is optional. Canvas wrap is acceptable.
- There is no time limit on when the artwork was created.
- **All artwork must be for sale.** All artwork is to be priced \$100 or under. Artists receive 75% of the sale.
- Artists must pick up work that has not sold on Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> between 3:00—3:45 p.m. Any art not picked up may be subject to storage cost of \$5 per piece.
- By entering this show, the artist grants the Olympic Peninsula Art Association (OPAA) permission to photograph and use digital images of his/her artwork for purposes of documentation, education, and publicity. The artist understands that at OPAA’s discretion, artwork and/or photos of the artwork, the artist’s photograph, and name may be released for use by newspaper or other media including the OPAA newsletter, website and Facebook page. The artist understands while the OPAA uses extreme care with artwork, OPAA assumes no responsibility for damage, loss and/or theft of artwork.
- Once accepted into the show, original artwork(s) must be brought to the city venue on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup> between 10 a.m.-2:00 p.m. for display in the show & sale. 2D artwork must have the entry label attached to the back-top left, and 3D artwork must have the label attached to the bottom.
